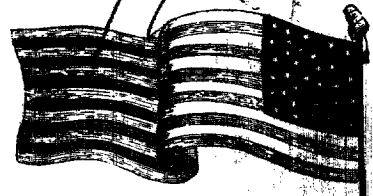

THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,

On all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE**,

Warrant No. *40,651* for *160* acres, in favor of *John Ozman*
Private, Captain Bryan's Company *Maryland*
Militia War 1812

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon *the South East quarter, of*
Section Three, in Township Twenty Seven, North of
Range Thirty Three, West; in the District of Lands
Subject to sale at Springfield Missouri contain-
ing One hundred and sixty acres

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** by
the **SURVEYOR GENERAL** *the said warrant having been assigned by*
the said John Ozman to David, C. Tandy, in whose
favor said tract had been located

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the **UNITED STATES** unto the said
David, C. Tandy, as assignee, as aforesaid, and
to his heirs

the tract of Land above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances
thereof, unto the said *David, C. Tandy, as assignee, as aforesaid*
and to his

heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, **I**, *James Buchanan*
PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent,
and the **SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE** to be hereunto affixed.

of *June* in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and *Fifty Nine*, and of the **INDEPENDENCE**
OF THE **UNITED STATES** the *Eighty Third*
